Child Advocates Needed

Advocates for Children is in need of individuals interested in becoming Court Appointed Special Advocate (CASA) volunteers for abused and neglected children in Jackson County. These volunteer advocates speak up for these vulnerable children in the court system and help ensure that children find a safe, permanent, and loving home as quickly as possible.

You can help change a child's life forever! No special educational background or experience is required to become a child's advocate. All CASA volunteers are thoroughly trained and fully supported by professional staff. Once assigned to a child by the Court, the CASA volunteer spends an average of 15-20 hours per month researching the situation and making recommendations about what should happen for each child. CASA volunteers serve as the "eyes and ears" of the Judge and are able to provide objective information to the court from the child's perspective.
