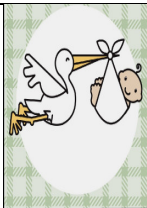
St. John the Baptist Day - Welcome Masons!

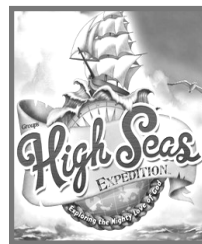
